Shoparoo

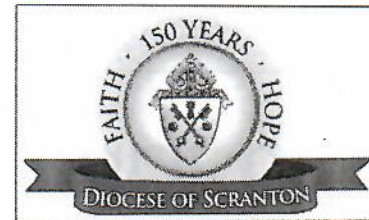
